

ROGER YUAN*Stunt/Fight Co-ordinator, Actor*

Since 1986 Los Angeles-born Roger Yuan has appeared alongside some of the very best-known names in Hollywood in films like *Lethal Weapon 4*, *Batman Begins* and *Syriana*, either as an actor in a lead or supporting role, or as stunt and/or fight co-ordinator or stunt man. He specialises in martial arts and is proficient in a number of weapons, particularly sword and staff. He is also a proficient horse rider, and was United Fighting Arts Federation Middleweight Champion variously between 1989 and 1996. In addition, he has a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of California Los Angeles and has trained under Rick Padilla, Stella Adler's William Chow, and Sal Landi of the Actors' Workshop. He is fluent in Mandarin Chinese. Now resident in Ireland, he retains his US passport and is available for work worldwide.
