For the past thirteen years, Warwick has been a DoP and operator of choice of the BBC's Natural History Unit in Bristol. He has worked with most formats of film and digital, and is a specialist in time-lapse, high speed, green- and blue-screen, motion control, aerial photography, macro and extreme close-up, infra red, time-slice and other techniques. He has worked extensively with wild and dangerous animals and in extreme environments in some 45 countries. This year he starts work on the BBC's new series 'Frozen Planet', and is also camera testing for the forthcoming Disney features 'Orangutans: One Minute To Midnight' and 'Chimp'. In the meantime, he remains very interested in feature film main and 2nd unit work, particularly in challenging environments. Based in Bristol, he is available for work worldwide and has dual British and Australian nationality.
